Cages

CAS wish to see that you bring your own cage (according to CAS standard), for hygienic reasons and reducing the risk of infections. There will be cages available for you to borrow.

Entry and fees

Follow the instructions on www.caschilla.se or Facebook to make your entry. Information on important dates concerning the show will also be available there. Your entry is binding.

Fees for entry: Members 70 SEK/chinchilla, others 100 SEK/chinchilla Fee, Open group: 100 SEK/chinchilla. Entry at show.

Please notice last entry date! Entries made after the last entry date is invalid.

Ages and groups

- Senior 1 year and older (pedigree), categorized by color (see information on group/color below).
- Veteran from 8 years and older (pedigree).
- Champion for chinchillas that has been awarded with 3 certs.
- Pet, chinchillas without pedigrees, regardless gender, age, color.
- Junior 8-12 months (pedigree), categorized by color.
- Baby 4-8 months (pedigree), categorized by color.
- Grand Champion for chinchillas that has been awarded with 87 p or more, twice in Champion group.
- Open group (entry at show).

Award ceremony, awards and show results

Award ceremonies will take place continuously during the day. You can retrieve your chinchilla after the award ceremony for its group is completed.

It is your responsibility to attend the check in and award ceremony.

Awards:

- Best in Senior (BIS), Best in Junior (BIJ) and Best in Baby (BIB)
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd price. In Pet only "Best Pet" and in veteran only "Best Veteran".
- Certificate = 83 p or more.
- Champion = 3 cert, by at least two different judges.

 One of the certificates must have been atained in Senior group.
- Grand Champion = 87 p twice in Champion group.
- Top Point = the highest score of the day.
- Judges favorite.
- Special awards.

Awards will not be sent by mail.

Responsibilities

You are responsible for making sure that your chinchillas are in good health while attending the show. You have the ultimate responsibility for your chinchilla/chinchillas during the day. CAS and its officials will not take responsibility for damage, if not proven for obvious flaws due to exhibition arrangements. Before making your entry, it is your responsibility to read the Show regulations.

- You are not allowed to comb or brush your chinchillas at the location of the show.
- Only chinchillas are allowed. Due to allergies.
- You are responsible for making sure that your chinchilla/chinchillas; during the last four (4) weeks has not been in contact with or have suffered from fungus or dermatomykos etc., during the last two (2) months has not been in contact with or has suffered from any form of parasitic or bacterial disease such as giardia, enteritis, coccidia and listeria.
- You are responsible for making sure that your female chinchilla/chinchillas is/are not pregnant or lactating.
- Regarding chinchillas that has been imported or exposed to environmental change, are not to be
 entered in any show for the following 30 days. This is to prevent infection that can be triggered by
 stress.

If you have any questions regarding the show, entry etc., please contact the show coordinator. CAS holds the rights to make changes in the Show regulations when needed.
